- Serves as an educational outreach site for dental programs
- Powered by the Twin Cities community – both via volunteering and financial philanthropic support

History

- Founded in 1965 with the help of the U of M School of Dentistry
- Part of the Union Gospel Mission until July 2017
- Then, spun off to become independent 501(c)3 called Hope Dental Clinic
- Moved to new clinic location in January 2018



Why We Are Needed

- Over 1.5 Million Minnesotans do not have dental insurance
- Those without insurance are more likely to go without needed dental care, which often means simple problems become bigger problems
- There are very few places to receive free dental care in the Twin Cities metro area

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

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
