 Health Insurance: Students are required to purchase health insurance. The cost of health insurance is included in this estimate. Students may submit a Cost of Attendance Appeal to include the cost of health insurance in their financial aid assessment. Students may elect to purchase the University's Student Health Benefit Plan (SHBP) or private insurance. The 2018-2019 rate for SHBP single student coverage is \$111/quarter for Fall and Spring semesters. The SHBP rate for Summer semester is \$612.
