The University of Minnesota School of Dentistry Program for Advanced Standing Students (UMN PASS) is a 29-month program for graduates of dental schools outside of the United States and Canada. Graduates earn their Doctor of Dental Surgery (D.D.S.) degree to practice general dentistry in the United States. UMN PASS is one of the only programs that prepares graduates for the Canadian dental board examinations in addition to the USA examinations. 16 students are admitted each year and work together as a cohort.

UMN PASS is an **integrated** program, which provides the same clinical education that domestic students receive at the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry. All instruction is **research-based**, taught by **top faculty** who are leaders in dentistry, and incorporates **leading dental techniques**, skills, and tools. UMN PASS facilitates a smooth transition into the United States and Canadian dental profession with 100% employment after graduation.

Application Requirements

Citizenship and Immigration Eligibility

• All applicants of all citizenships are eligible and welcome to apply

Required Standardized Tests

- Passing score on the INBDE or NBDE
- TOEFL MyBest 94 minimum with 20 in each section taken within the last 3 years

Transcript Evaluation

• Educational Credential Evaluators (ECE) of your dental degree from an institution outside the US and Canada

Letters of Evaluations Instructions

• Submit 3 letters of recommendation as part of your ADEA CAAPID application

Supplemental Fee

• Pay the supplemental fee
